We use CAN to: a) talk about possibility and ability b) make requests c) ask for or give permission. We use COULD to: a) talk about past possibility or ability b) make requests. We include BE ABLE TO here for convenience, but it is not an auxiliary verb., Should you use can or could? Understanding how all the modal verbs are used is vital to speaking and writing English effectively and idiomatically., Modals “ could and couldn't
