Human Chromosomes “ Pieces of DNA that are found within the nucleus of a human cell. Biologists take chromosomes in their condensed form during mitosis, cut them out and organize them in pairs. This produces a product called a karyotype., To study human inheritance, biologists use pedigree charts. A pedigree chart shows relationships within a family. The inheritance of a trait can be traced through the family. From this, biologists may determine the genotypes of family members. It is difficult to link an observed human trait with a specific gene.,
