COHEN TANNOUDJI SOLUTIONS PDF - Search results, Otto Stern (17 February 1888 – 17 August 1969) was a German American physicist and Nobel laureate in physics. He was the second most nominated person for a Nobel Prize with 82 nominations in the years 1925–1945 (most times nominated is Arnold Sommerfeld with 84 nominations), ultimately winning in 1943. After its breakaway from RhÃne-Poulenc, Rhodia had to cope with the repercussions of soil pollution and financial liabilities.
