1. Cost Definitions Cost: The total money, time, and resources associated with a purchase or activity. Fixed cost: Includes all costs that do not vary with activity for an accounting period. Fixed costs are, at any time, the inevitable costs that must be paid regardless of the level, A cost estimate is the approximation of the cost of a program, project, or operation. The cost estimate is the product of the cost estimating process. The cost estimate has a single total value and may have identifiable component values., In software development, effort estimation is the process of predicting the most realistic amount of effort (expressed in terms of person-hours or money) required to develop or maintain software based on incomplete, uncertain and noisy input. Effort estimates may be used as input to project plans,
