Staircase-Escalante National Monument  
(GSENM) is a United States national  
monument that originally designated  
1,880,461 acres (7,610 km<sup>2</sup>) of protected  
land in southern Utah in 1996. The  
monument's size was later reduced by a  
succeeding presidential proclamation in  
2017. The land is among the most remote in  
the country being the last to be mapped in  
the contiguous United States., For most of  
the year, the Escalante River is a small  
stream, easily stepped across or  
waded. During spring runoff and the summer  
monsoon, however, the river can become a  
raging, muddy torrent ten to one hundred  
times bigger., The Bryce Canyon National  
Park and Garfield County areas of Utah have  
hiking trails that range from the three day  
backpacking trip of Coyote Gulch / Hurricane  
Wash to the quick Tunnel Trail ., There are

lots of places to explore around Capitol Reef  
National Park. Find trail information for  
ATV/OHV's, hiking, biking, horseback riding,
