In the case of academic evaluation for tenure it is sometimes inappropriate to use the impact of the source journal to estimate the expected frequency of a recently published article. Again, the impact factor should be used with informed peer review., The median Impact factor is the median value of all journals impact factors in the subject category. The journal impact factor extenuates the significance of absolute citation frequencies. It alleviates the advantage of large journals over small journals because large journals circulate a larger body of citable literature., The impact

factor (IF) is a measure of the frequency with which the average article in a journal has been cited in a particular year. It is used to measure the importance or rank of a journal by calculating the times its articles are cited.,

Impact Factor is a journal-level metric; it is the average number of times a journal's articles specifically, those published in a 2-year period were cited in 2016. Impact Factors are calculated for journals selected for and indexed, The term "impact factor" has gradually evolved to describe both journal and author impact. Journal impact factors generally involve relatively large populations of articles and citations. Individual authors generally produce smaller numbers of articles, although some have published a phenomenal number.
