The term ethics derives from Ancient Greek ἠθικός (ethikos), from ἤθεια (ēthia), meaning 'habit, custom'. The field of ethics, along with aesthetics concern matters of value, and thus comprise the branch of philosophy called axiology. Ethics (also known as moral philosophy) is the branch of philosophy which addresses questions of morality. The word "ethics" is commonly used interchangeably with 'morality,' and sometimes it is used more narrowly to mean the moral principles of a particular tradition, group, or individual.", 1.
