The first printed work to contain the New Testament in Greek was the Complutensian Polyglot Bible by Cardinal Francisco Jim nez de Cisneros, printed in 1514, but not published until 1520. The Codex Alexandrinus (London, British Library, MS Royal 1.D. V-VIII; Gregory-Aland no. A or 02, Soden   4) is a fifth-century manuscript of the Greek Bible, containing the majority of the Septuagint and the New Testament. It is one of the four Great uncial codices. Along with the Codex Sinaiticus and the Vaticanus, it is one of the earliest and most complete manuscripts of the Bible.
