and composer. Born in Geneva, his political
philosophy influenced the progress of the
Enlightenment throughout Europe, as well as
aspects of the French Revolution and the
development of modern political and
educational thought. *Emile, or On Education*
or *Émile, or Treatise on Education*
(French: *Émile, ou De l'éducation*) is
a treatise on the nature of education and on
the nature of man written by Jean-Jacques
Rousseau, who considered it to be the "best
and most important" of all his writings. Due to
a section of the book entitled "Profession of
Faith of the Savoyard Vicar", *Emile* was
banned in Paris and Geneva and ...,
Jean-Jacques Rousseau (Geneva, 28 juni

1712 - Ermenonville, 2 juli 1778) was een
