(AVICENNA). Ibn Sina (Avicenna)
(980-1037) is one of the foremost
philosophers of the golden age of Islamic
tradition that also includes al-Farabi and Ibn

(Leader among the wise men) a title that was
given to him by his students. His
philosophical works were one of the main
targets of al-Ghazali's attack on

philosophical influences in Islam., Why an entry on Machiavelli? Abu'l-Walid Ibn Rushd, better known as Averroes (1126-1198), stands out as a towering figure in the history of Arab-Islamic thought, as well as that of West-European philosophy and theology., Aimed at both the intelligent layman and the professional economist, this book is the most comprehensive and intellectually powerful explanation of the nature and value of laissez-faire capitalism that has ever been written., Edward B. Tylor's Primitive Culture articulates one of two major theories of culture to emerge around 1870.
